ABOUT THE VINTAGE

The 2022 growing season in Sonoma County produced excellent fruit. Winter rains eased drought, followed by a dry spring with mild temperatures and March bud break. A September heatwave and mid-month rains slowed harvest, allowing grapes to concentrate, resulting in structured wines with rich, luxurious tannins.

WINEMAKING NOTES

The grapes for this wine were harvested in the early morning of September 12 from prestigious vineyards in Sonoma County. Picked at the peak of perfection, this Rosé reflects the region's warm days and cool evening breezes that preserve natural acidity.

TASTING NOTES

A deep salmon-pink hue introduces this wine, revealing aromas of chocolate, cassis, and earthy undertones, accented by hints of red fruit and cedar. The palate is full-bodied and well-balanced, unfolding layers of blackberry, white pepper, and savory herbs at the core. Silky, plush tannins and a finely woven structure carry through to a lingering, nuanced finish.
